



FMBB commissions - Regulations

1. Presentation

- a. The FMBB Commissions are non-mandatory commissions of the FMBB. The assignment of the commissions is to represent and to take care of the good functioning of the FMBB's World Championships different disciplines.
- b. FMBB commissions for the following disciplines are existing: IGP, Mondioring, Agility, Obedience, Exposition, Canicross/Bikejöring, IHT TS Herding.
- c. The FMBB Commissions are made up of delegates from clubs/countries which are a member of the FMBB and want to have a representative in the different commissions.
- d. The clubs/countries have to be member in the kennel club in their country.
- e. The delegates have to be member in the Belgian Shepherd Club in their country.
- f. Belgian Shepherd Clubs that are interested to propose a delegate to join a commission can propose this to the FMBB corresponding Commission. If the commission has a positive advice for the candidate commission member, the commission will inform the FMBB board, then the FMBB Board will take a final decision.
- g. Maximum seven members per commission.
- h. The FMBB Commissions are led by their commission members in college.
- i. A commission secretary will be appointed by every commission. The "commission secretary" will take care of all communications between the commission and the FMBB Board.
- j. The different FMBB Commissions keeps the implementation rules up to date for the different disciplines. Every change in these rules must be send to the FMBB board for definitive approval.

2. Meetings and reports.

- a. The FMBB Commissions meets through electronic means (Zoom, Skype, email, Facebook or other) or at the annual FMBB World Championships. This at least two times per year.
- b. From all meetings, a report must be written and sent to all commission members for the approval. After approval by the commission members, the reports will be send to the FMBB secretary that informs the FMBB Board for final approval.

3. Duration of the mandate as commission member.

- a. If a commission member is absent from a commission meeting twice in a row without apology, this will automatically be submitted to the FMBB board. The FMBB board then decides whether the commission member can remain in the commission or not.
- b. If a commission member gives no answer after 3 send mails coming from the commission or the FMBB board, we assume that this commission member has no longer interest to be part of the commission and will be considered as resigned. This can only be confirmed by the FMBB board.
