Specifications for the organization of the FMBB World Championships Mondioring

1) Rules:

The competition is judged by International FCI Mondioring judges following the FCI Mondioring Rules

2) The FMBB Mondioring World Championships exits in three Levels:

1. The FMBB Mondioring World Championship (level 3).
2. The FMBB Mondioring World Winner level 1.
3. The FMBB Mondioring World Winner level 2.

3) Judges:

- a. 4 trial judges and a supervisor will be appointed by the FMBB board . They will be chosen after propositions of the Mondioring Commission and the local organizer. The board will decide upfront who will judge Level 3 and who will judge level 1 & 2 .
- b. Judges from different Nationalities will be chosen in the different levels.
- c. The decision of the trial judges shall be final and incontestable.
- d. The supervisor is there:
 1. to check the program has no violations against the FCI rules
 2. To be the contact person between the judges and the competitors (through their Team leader.) in case of misunderstanding. He is not deciding only advising.
 3. He is checking the results if no mistakes are made.
- e. In case of official complain, check the general specifications to organize the FMBB World championship. (rule 25 Protest)

4) Helpers:

- a. 5 helpers will be appointed by the FMBB Board They will be chosen after propositions of the Mondioring Commission and the local organizer. 2 helpers will be appointed upfront for Level 1 & 2 and 3 helpers will be appointed upfront for Level 3.

- b. The helpers from level 3 will be stand in for the Level 1 & 2 helpers and reversed.
- c. The helpers will be chosen from different Nationalities.
- d. The helpers must respect the competition rules and follow the instructions of the judges.

5) Admission and registration of competitors:

- a. Maximum participants per country:
 - 1. Level 3 maximum 4 starters and 1 backup (if the time table allow 5 starters 1 back up can start)
One week after closing the entries the decision will be made if back up can start.
 - 2. The World Champion of the previous World Championship (level 3) is invited to defend his title and count as an extra competitor for his team, so his team goes to 5 starters and 1 backup.
 - 3. Level 2 1 starter and 1 back up (who start only when the starter of his country cannot start)
 - 4. Level 1 1 starter and 1 back up (who start only when the starter of his country cannot start)
- b. The maximum number of competitors at the Mondioring World championship level 3 is 60 and limited on 4 days of competition Thursday (16), Friday (16), Saturday (16) and Sunday (12). The Test dog level 3 will be on Wednesday late afternoon after competition Level 2.
- c. The number of competitors at the Mondioring World Cup level 1 & 2 is limited on 1 day of competition on Tuesday for level 1 and Wednesday for level 2. The test dog is done the day before the competition.
- d. Every competitor can present maximum one dog in every level.
- e. Helpers or Judges and 1st degree family members with an official function in the FMBB Mondioring World Championship and World Cup, cannot participate.
- f. To participate in Level 1, the dog must have competed in this level at least one time with minimum of 160 points in the year preceding the FMBB championship .
- g. To participate in Level 2, the dog must have competed in this level at least one time with minimum of 240 points in the year preceding the FMBB championship.
- h. To participate in cat Level 3, the dog must have competed in this level at least one time with minimum of 320 points in the year preceding the FMBB championship.
- i. Once competed in Level 2 or 3, it is not allowed to participate in a lower class.
- j. Dogs in level 1 & 2 are not allowed to start second time in same level in the following years.
- k. Competitors are not allowed to compete in more than one discipline with the same dog at the FMBB Championships (except exposition).

6) Classification and titles

- a. Individual competition
 - 1. The participant in Level 3 who obtained the best score is the winner and obtains the title FMBB Mondioring World Champion and a invitation for the next FMBB World championship.
 - 2. The participants in Level 2 and 1 who obtained the best score in their Level will be declared winner and obtains the title FMBB Mondioring World Cup Winner Level 2 and respectively FMBB Mondioring World Cup Winner Level 1.
 - 3. Price giving and celebration for Level 1 & 2 is done 1 hour after ending Level 2 on the field or at

Saturday evening banquet, depending on the organizer.

4. In the case of equal points, the highest score in the biting discipline will first make the decision, the best score in the obedience discipline in second place, following the best score in the jumping exercises. If all the points in all the disciplines are the same, they are designated in the same place, (example: 2 x place 4 = 1, 2, 3, 4, 4, 6, 7...).
5. The highest score in the disciplines: biting, obedience and jumping will be calculated with deduction of the General Appearance points in the discipline where this G.A. are taken.

b. Team competition:

1. The total of the three highest results per team/country in Level 3 shall be considered for the team result.

7) Mondioring Competition Director:

- a. The local organizing National Belgian Shepherd Club who is responsible for the organization of the Mondioring competition, shall provide a qualified person who will be the Mondioring Competition Director and whose work shall include, in particular:
 1. Having a good collaboration with the FMBB board and the Mondioring commission in particular
 2. Technical running of the trial.
 3. Provision, planning and equipment of a sufficiently large trial area (minimum closed field of 4000m² and maximum 5000m²), with a covered grandstand(if possible).
 4. Providing a sufficient number of qualified helpers (technical helpers on the field, writers, office personnel, etc.).
 5. Provide a place near to the field that can be completely closed so 2 decoy can hide while the 3rd decoy is executing the research of the decoy. It must be located at least 5m from the field, so that the dogs cannot doubt about his presence.
 6. Shower and a physiotherapist for the decoys when finished their daily task.
 7. He is organizing all needs for judges, helpers and staff (food, drinks, transport to hotel)
 8. He is responsible to have a ring commissioner, who speaks at least French and English:
 - For Cat 1&2 (with experience and can be a national judge).
 - For Cat 3 one of the two judges who judged Cat 1&2 will be the ring commissioner
 9. At noon a short break with some sandwiches is advised on the field so no time is lost. In the evening a well-served diner is obligatory for the judges and helpers.
- b. The organizer will place at the disposal of the Judges all necessary equipment to carry out the competitions as foreseen by the international FCI rules.

8) Mondioring Competition Secretariat:

- a. The secretariat will be organized on the Mondioring competition field. So provide a shelter with direct access to the field and that can be closed for security purposes, so in absence of the staff nobody can enter.
- b. Computer with mouse and printer with the Mondioring program to calculate the results. Reserve computer and printer should be ready to use and all should be compatible.

- c. Electric and internet connection for the computers
- d. Enough paper for printing and reserve toner should be there.
- e. Place to put the results, and all the necessary things to put it out.
- f. Normal office materiel: Pen - Pencils - Eraser - Typex - Stapler - Hole Punch – Highlighter- Calculator – Scissors
- g. Prepare stickers to put in the Scorebooks with mention: FMBB 20.. WC Mondioring
- h. This secretariat will organize the drawing for all levels and make up a list with timetable.
- i. They will organize all paperwork necessary for the judges and competitors.
- j. The results achieved by the competitors will be clearly displayed as soon as available on a visible board near to the competition field.
- k. A fast and reliable working out of the trial results to determine the winner and order of placing.

9) Absolutely forbidden items during the World Championship:

- a. Animal abuse see point 24 FMBB WC General Implementation Rules.
 - b. No Bodycam or other filming devices worn by participants are accepted on the field during the competition.
